- **Ungnadia Speciosa – Mexican Buckeye (Native)**
- Sedum 'autumn joy' (Eurasia)
- **Amsonia jonesii – Jones' Bluestar (Native SW)**

WALL:

- **Spirea (Native Midwest to NE U.S.A)**
- Pyracantha – Fire Thorn, rose family (Native SE Asia and SE Europe)
- **Fraxinus cuspidate Fragrant ash – (Native west Texas, NM, AZ and into Mexico) Not doing well this year. Iron chlorosis**
- **Nolina (Native AZ, NM, northern Mexico)**
- David Austin rose – A Shropshire Lad

A 100 years later, it was found growing in the yard of Kintzley’s grandson in Fort Collins, Co.
